

**Halifax Hurricanes Ringette Association – FAQs
2026/2027**

1. 2026/2027 Registration Fees:

SPECIAL PROMOTION: Win your registration! One early bird registration prize draw will take place for players (skaters and goalies) who register with the Halifax Hurricanes Ringette Association by August 1st, 2026. This applies to all athletes from Active Start to U19 and also 18+.

OPTIONAL Jersey Replacement Package

First-year U12 athletes and new athletes at older levels, receive a set of personalized jerseys. Returning players needing replacement of lost, damaged, or mis-sized jerseys must purchase them through the RAMP Registration system as a package**. Please purchase this package as soon as possible to allow enough time for sizing and ordering jerseys.

Cost: \$125 for a full set

FUN2 or U10 - Optional Equipment Rental (full season October 2026 to March 2027)

Cost: \$100

Active Start or FUN1 - Optional Equipment Rental (half-season October to December 2026)

Cost: \$50

2. Divisions and Competitive Ringette:

- **Active Start/FUN 1/FUN 2:** Balanced teams on shared ice.
- **U10 and U12:** Balanced teams playing games.
- **U14/U16:** Halifax Athletes planning to play at U14 or U16 levels should go ahead and register with Halifax Hurricanes. More details will continue to be shared.
- **U19:** Balanced teams playing games.
- **18+:** Weekly games.

3. Which Division should I register my athlete?:

- Registration is based on an athlete's birth year and age as of December 31, 2025.
 - *Example 1:* if your athlete is 11 years old today but will turn 12 on December 4th, 2025, they should be registered in U14 for the upcoming season.
 - *Example 2:* if your athlete is 11 years old today but will turn 12 on January 29th, 2026, they should be registered in U12 for the upcoming season.

4. Promotions and Discounts:

Halifax Hurricanes Ringette Association is pleased to offer the following discounts. Please note that all athletes must be registered at the same time to utilize these codes. Only one code per family may be used (i.e., either Family Discount or New Player – but not both). If a promo code is used in error, the Registrar will reach out directly to balance the account prior to the start of season.

Family Discount (two players): \$50. Use Promo Code ‘**Family1**’

Family Discount (three + players): \$100. Use Promo Code ‘**Family2**’

New Player Discount: A New Player is someone registering in any division who has *never registered* for ringette before: 10% discount Use Promo Code ‘**NewPlayer**’

5. Payment Method:

Payment is to be made by credit card only. Payment may be made in full or in four installments with 25% due up front and the remainder due on September 15, October 15, and November 15. Credit card installment payments will be processed automatically.

If full payment has not been received, or payment arrangements have not been requested by November 15th, your registration shall be considered incomplete and this may impact participation in the upcoming season.

Credit Card: as with all vendors, there is an admin fee for credit card use. The fee charged by the registration app is 2.2%. The registration system accepts Visa Debit and Mastercard Debit in addition to Visa, Mastercard and American Express Credit Cards.

6. Can I request my athlete to be on the same team as a friend?:

Friend requests are only permitted in the U10 and U12 divisions. Friend requests must be reciprocal (they request each other). Only one request per athlete is permitted. Friend requests are not guaranteed and will only be considered if the request aligns with the creation of balanced teams once evaluations are completed. Requests must be made with registration.

Players that must leave for medical reasons may be considered for prorated refunds on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the HHRA Executive.

8. Team Fundraising Commitment:

Fundraising is mandatory for the effective running of an association/team and all Halifax Hurricanes players will be required to participate in this year's fundraising initiatives.

Players are required to participate in team fundraising, or contribute the equal raised by each player in financial funds, towards the approved team budget.

Teams are permitted to request a maximum initial parent contribution of \$150. Additional parent contributions may be requested/required at a later date, depending on the budget and fundraising outcomes. In the event that teams are left with surplus funds at the end of the season, funds attributed to parent contributions will be returned to the parents.

9. SportSweep Commitment:

SportSweep is a fundraising raffle hosted by Sport Nova Scotia which provides an opportunity to youth sport organizations to fundraise and support their programming. The Halifax Hurricanes have participated in the SportSweep raffle for the past 3 years.

This year, all athletes registered in FUN through U19 are required to sell at least 10 SportSweep tickets (total value \$50) in order to raise funds in support of continuing to provide new jerseys, fund new equipment, support other Association initiatives, and help mitigate future increases to registration fees. If your athlete intends to sell SportSweep tickets, please select "I agree" during the registration process. Team Managers will distribute the tickets for sale at a time determined by the Association. If an athlete has agreed to this commitment but does not sell tickets, they will be billed \$37.50 to their account after the fundraising campaign is complete.

Athletes may opt out of Sportsweep fundraising by selecting "I disagree" to this commitment during the registration process. If you select "I disagree" the Association will bill your athlete's account \$37.50 in addition to your regular registration fees.

10. Volunteer Commitment:

Our association is built on the strength of our volunteers, and it is expected that all families will contribute to the Halifax Hurricanes Ringette Association throughout the season. With the Halifax Hurricanes co-hosting the Gary Field Tournament this year, each team will be required to contribute a set number of volunteer hours to the tournament to help ensure its success.

In addition, HHRA has committed to hosting the 2027 Ringette NS Provincial Tournament, which will also require a volunteer commitment from all teams. We've also got some fun HHRA Community Activities planned that you can help make a success. Thanks for everything you do for the Hurricanes!

11. Photo Waiver / Release and HHRA Live Stream Waiver:

During the registration process you will be asked to review and provide your agreement related to the use of photos and live streaming. Please read the full waiver and release statements on the registration form carefully and indicate your agreement or disagreement.

Please note that photo capable devices are NOT permitted in arena dressing rooms at any time.
