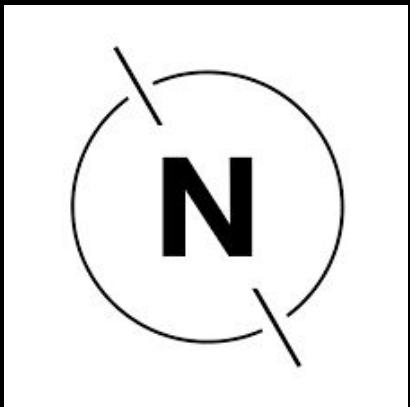

# BCHL JR. BULLDOGS BILLETING

- BILLETING IS AN INCREDIBLY REWARDING EXPERIENCE AND GIVES FAMILIES THE OPPORTUNITY TO BECOME A PLAYER'S HOME AWAY FROM HOME DURING THE HOCKEY SEASON.
- OUR PLAYERS ARE TYPICALLY 17–20 YEARS OLD AND ARE HERE TO FOCUS ON HOCKEY, SCHOOL, AND PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT. BILLET FAMILIES PROVIDE A PRIVATE ROOM, MEALS, AND A SUPPORTIVE ENVIRONMENT WHILE PLAYERS BECOME PART OF THE FAMILY THROUGHOUT THE SEASON.
- PLAYERS ARE EXPECTED TO RESPECT HOUSE RULES, HELP OUT AROUND THE HOME, AND BE POSITIVE MEMBERS OF THE HOUSEHOLD. THEY ARE ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN TOILETRIES, SUPPLEMENTS, AND PERSONAL ITEMS.
- A MONTHLY STIPEND IS PROVIDED TO HELP OFFSET COSTS, AND TRANSPORTATION IS NOT THE RESPONSIBILITY OF BILLET FAMILIES. IF NEEDED, PLAYERS ARE PAIRED WITH TEAMMATES FOR RIDES THROUGHOUT THE SEASON.
- WE ARE CURRENTLY LOOKING FOR BOTH TEMPORARY AND FULL-SEASON BILLET HOMES. PLAYERS ARRIVE FOR CAMP SEPTEMBER 4–6, WITH MOVE-IN DAY SCHEDULED FOR SEPTEMBER 7.
- ALL ADULTS (18+) LIVING IN THE HOME ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE A VULNERABLE SECTOR CHECK, AND A HOME VISIT IS COMPLETED BEFORE PLAYERS ARRIVE.

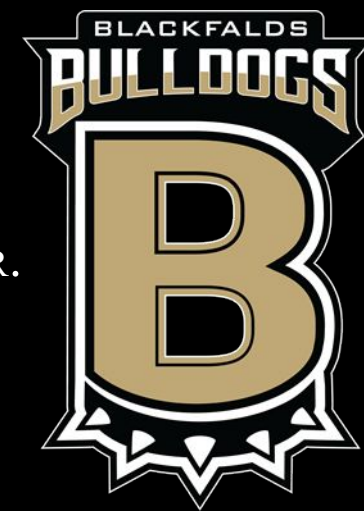
