Policy Title: Intro to Hockey Tournament Proceeds Policy

1.0 OVERVIEW

This policy outlines the allocation of proceeds from the Intro to Hockey Tournament hosted by the Cochrane Minor Hockey Association (CMHA), specifically for the U7 and U9 divisions. The purpose is to ensure that the funds generated from these tournaments are reinvested into the Intro to Hockey program to support its growth and development.

2.0 SCOPE

This policy applies to all proceeds generated from the annual U7 and U9 Intro to Hockey tournaments organized by the Cochrane Minor Hockey Association.

3.0 PROCESS

The Cochrane Minor Hockey Association (CMHA) is committed to fostering the development of young hockey players through its Intro to Hockey program. To help sustain and enhance this program, at the discretion of the CMHA Board, 50% of the proceeds from both the U7 and U9 Intro to Hockey tournaments may be retained by the CMHA. These funds will be used exclusively to support and further develop the Intro to Hockey program, including but not limited to:

- Equipment and gear purchases
- Program development and coaching resources
- Facility and ice time expenses
- Scholarships or financial assistance for participants in need

The remaining 50% of the proceeds may be allocated to the participating Cochrane U7 and U9 teams that participate in event organization and volunteer coordination.

4.0 IMPLEMENTATION

- The Tournament Committee will track all revenue and expenses associated with the U7 and U9 tournaments.
- After the conclusion of the tournament, CMHA will review a summary of the revenue generated, expenses incurred, and the amount to be allocated to the Intro to Hockey program and Cochrane U7 and U9 teams
