



OVERVIEW

In order to create a healthy, safe environment which is conducive to learning the Innisfil Minor Baseball Organization has established a “Code of Conduct.” Our goal is to emphasize and teach our players through the principles of fair play, sportsmanship, inclusiveness, and commitment in order to develop a strong respect amongst players, coaches, parents, umpires and spectators. Our Community.

The Code of Conduct shall govern the actions of players, coaches, parents, umpires and spectators. The intention is to establish clear behavioral expectations for all those involved. As it is impossible to forecast every foreseeable situation or issue, the Code of Conduct shall be used as a reference tool with regards to any issue that falls outside of what is outlined within the Code of Conduct below.

The IMBA will make this Code of Conduct available publically on its website, as well as by request. Therefore, it is the obligation of all players, coaches, parents, umpires and spectators to be aware of, as well as to comply with the Code of Conduct as outlined below. Any person violating any of the terms outlined in the Code shall be subject to disciplinary action at the discretion of the IMBA Board of Executives, including termination of the person’s status as a member.

PLAYERS

- Always be on time for practices.
- Always be on time for games and ready to play (dressed in your uniform, prepared with your equipment).
- Show respect for your teammates, coaches and opponents by:
 - Giving maximum effort to the best of your ability
 - Not missing an unreasonable amount of games or practices (for reasons other than injuries)
 - Listening to your coaches at all time
 - Supporting your teammates (encouragement, cheering, being positive)
- Do not invite friends, or parents into the dugout or playing area unless the coaches permit them to be there.
- Be courteous to the umpires, the other team and its coaches.
- Foul language (swearing), negative comments, aggressive behavior or fighting is not allowed at ANY TIME.
- Ensure all trash is removed from dugouts even if you didn't put it there.
- Follow the coach's rules for team equipment.
- It is your responsibility to maintain good communication with your coaches if you are not going to attend a game or practice (with sufficient notice)
