Cancellations/TBRs

1. When a team receives confirmation of acceptance into a tournament, and it conflicts with a league scheduled game, they must contact their opponent to cancel the league game. This notice must be provided within 48 hours of admission to the tournament. The commissioner must be copied, and the reason for cancellation must be stated.

The hosting team will need to contact their association to release the floor time and officials."

2. If a team is requesting to cancel or reschedule a game, they must contact their opponents and make the request. The reason for the cancellation or reschedule must be stated. The commissioner must be copied on any communications. Notice must be provided at least 7 days before the date of the scheduled game, to allow time for the commissioner to review the request. Once the commissioner approved the cancellation or TBR, the host team is responsible for releasing the floor and officials.

Condensed Proposal:

- For tournament applications and scheduling the first 10 games of the season, teams will self-declare a calibre. Teams will be named and numbered sequentially. IE: Poco U11-1. Poco U11-2, ETC
- The season will be released in three phases: Phase 1 based on self-declarations, Phases 2 & 3 - based on MyLaxRankings or another ranking algorithm.
- Schedules will feature interplay across the entire division in all phases.
- The number of games prescribed is approximate to allow flexibility.
- Regular season: April 6 – June 29, 2026.
- Teams add extra games including interleague play
- Cross calibre games will be the responsibility of the home team's commissioner.
