

Year End CAHL Governor Report

The CAHL Governor is a unique position on the board. It is a volunteer provided by Redcliff Minor Hockey Association to CAHL to govern a group of teams within the league. This involves assisting the planning of the tiering stage, communicating and tracking suspensions, verifying data entry on gamesheets after each game is played, and supporting the teams managers.

As a first time CAHL Governor I faced a steep learning curve. This was compounded by the division I was assigned, U18T3W. This is the lowest level of competitive hockey in U18 and because there is no lower tier you tend to have less balance in the strength of teams. Combine that with U18 hormones and players aging out of minor hockey and it's a recipe for suspensions. This year I handed out around 70 suspensions totalling around 170 games.

I am confident that I represented our association well and the year-end feedback I received from the teams in my division and the CAHL Lead Governors reflected that.
