



How to Create a Spordle Account

A step-by-step guide for MHAs & registrars to access the Hockey Canada Registry (HCR)

Why you need a Spordle Login

- A Spordle account grants you access to your personal Hockey Canada profile, and you can link members of your family to your account
- Those that are in executive roles with MHAs (registrar, etc) will have their personal Spordle account linked to the MHAs HCR in order to complete the following:
 - Access to registration and participant records
 - Ability to manage teams, coaches, and volunteers
 - Required for rostering & insurance
 - Certification tracking

If you use an MHA specific email, you can create a Spordle login with the MHA email



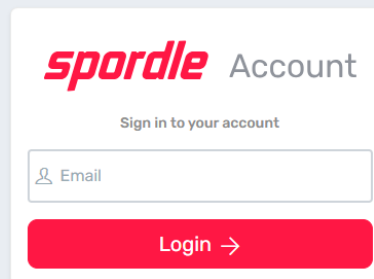
Step 1

Create a Spordle Login

No existing Spordle Login

- Link to Spordle: <https://myaccount.spordle.com/login>
 - Save this to your browser bookmarks
- “Sign up” and follow the prompts

If you already have an existing Spordle account that you would like to use for your MHA role, you can skip to Step 2

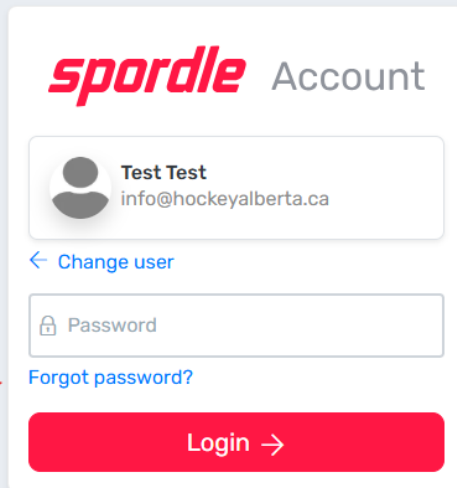
Step 1

Create a Spordle Login

Forget Login/unsure of login info

Not sure if you have a Spordle login?- enter your email & “login”

- If you **have** an account it will prompt for a Password
 - Can't recall/don't have password – choose “Forgot Password”
- If you **do not** have an account it will prompt you to sign up

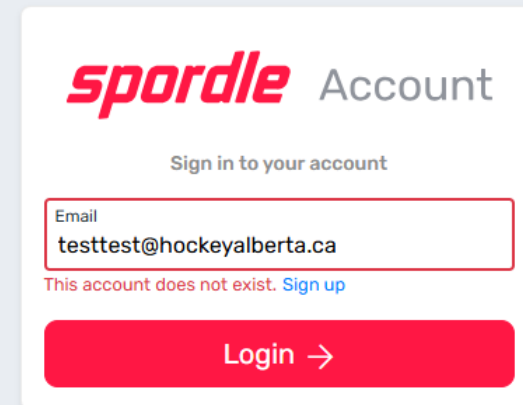

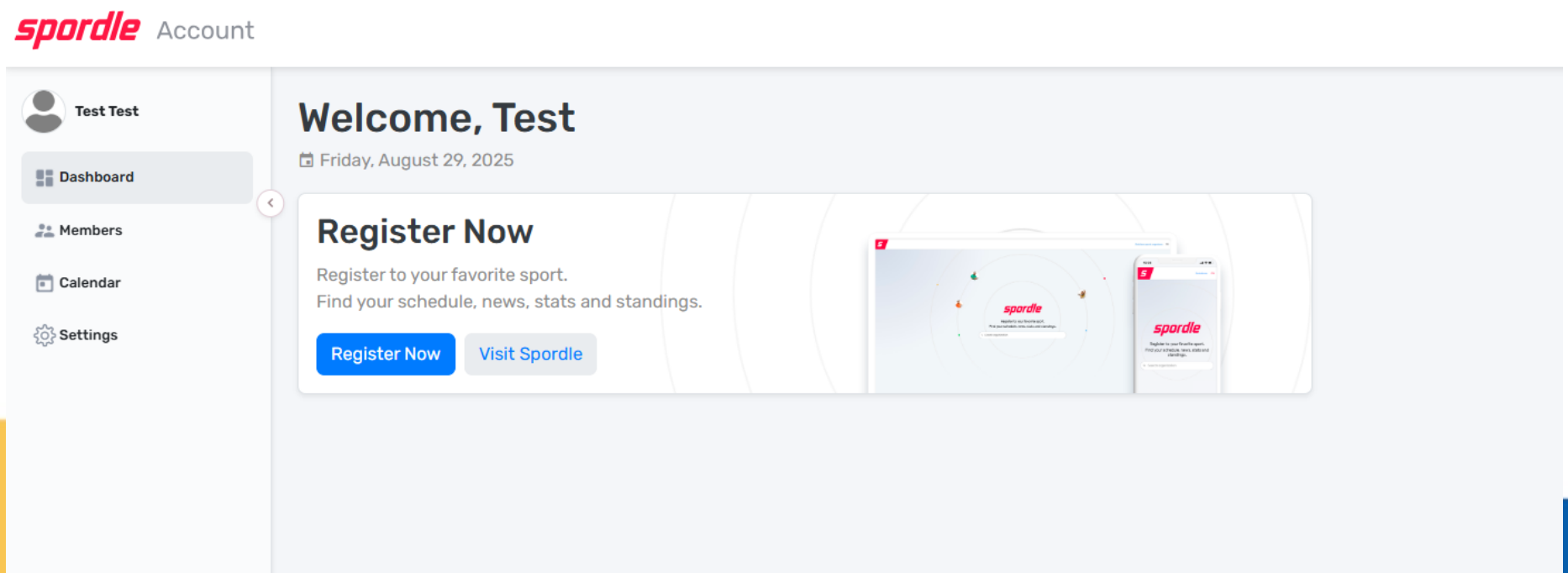

Step 1

Create a Spordle Login

- Once all prompts have been completed, you should end up with a page that looks like this:



Step 2

Communicate account creation

- Confirm with the Individual/League/Team/Association that you have finished creating a Spordle login, and are ready for access to HCR - **this can take up to 5 business days to complete.**



Step 3

Confirm Access

- Log back into your Spordle account
- You will now be able to “Manage” your associations HCR account from your Dashboard

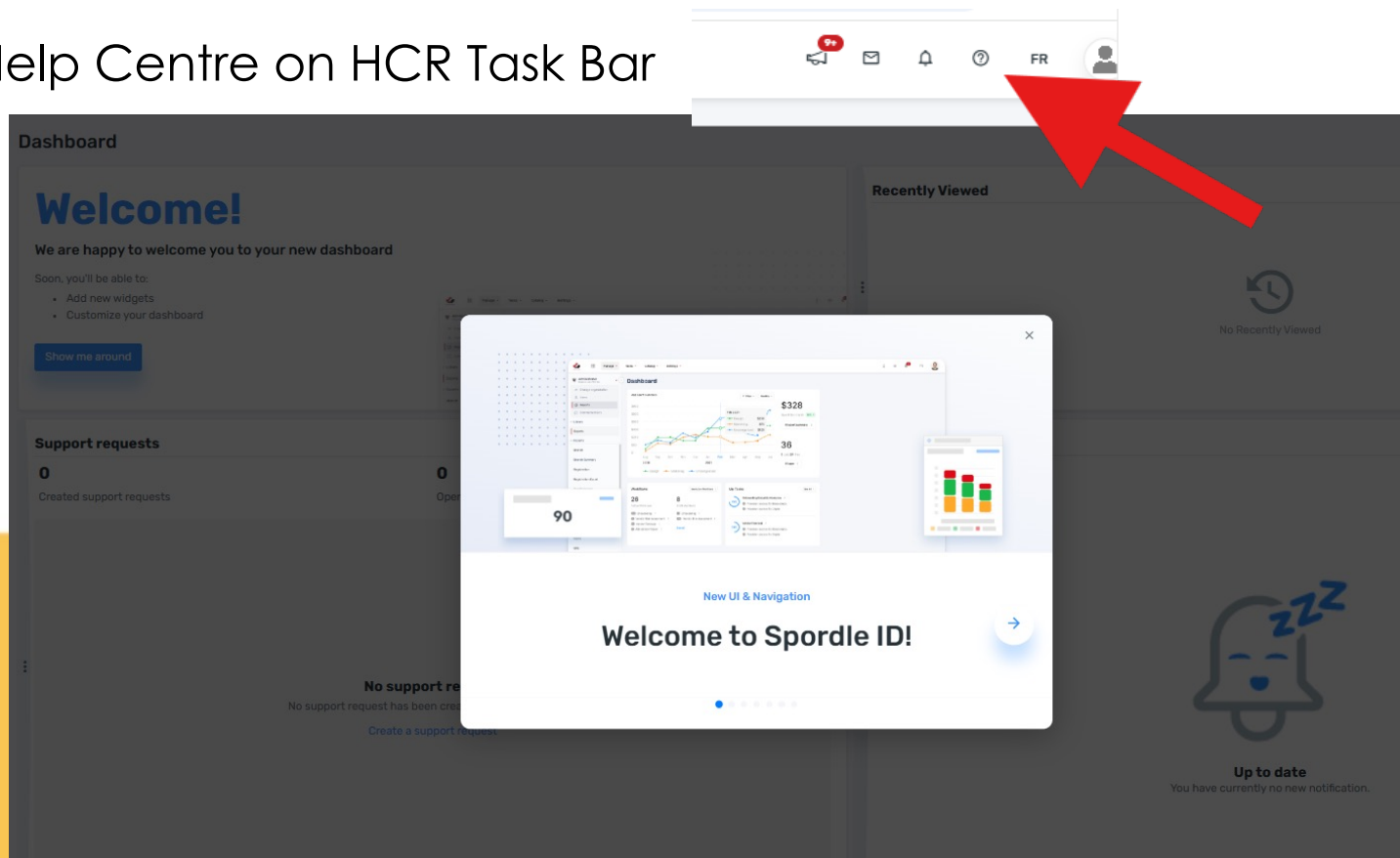

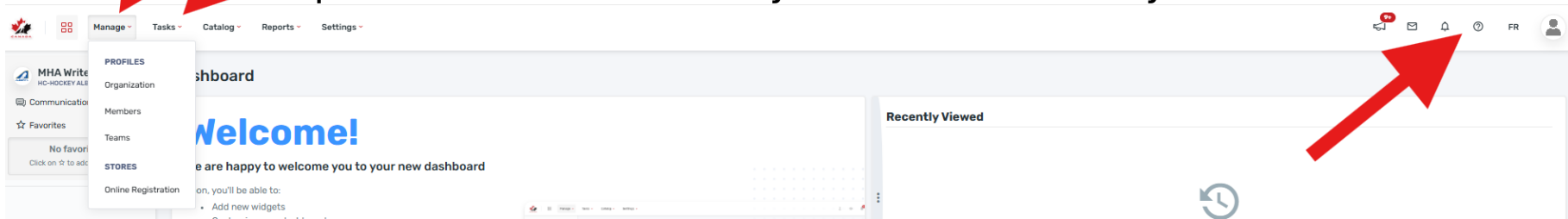
