DRESS CODE

Elite / High Performance Teams

Players (Male):

- Dress pants with a shirt and tie (optional), or a team golf shirt, are required for all games.
- No blue jeans.
- A sports jacket, club jacket, or other neat, presentable coat is acceptable.
- Team tracksuits may be worn for practices only.
- Dress shoes or other clean presentable dressy shoes must be worn to all games.
- No hats of any kind may be worn to games or on the bench.
- All "club jackets" must be approved by Red Deer Minor Hockey.

Players (Female):

- Dress pants and dress shirts are required for all games.
- No blue jeans.
- A sports jacket, club jacket, or other neat, presentable coat is acceptable.
- Team tracksuits may be worn for practices only.
- Dress shoes or other clean presentable dressy shoes must be worn to all games.
- No hats of any kind may be worn to games or on the bench.
- All "club jackets" must be approved by Red Deer Minor Hockey.

Coaches & Team Managers:

- Dress pants with a shirt and tie (optional) are required for all games.
- No blue jeans.
- A sports jacket, club jacket, or other neat, presentable coat is acceptable.
- No ball caps permitted on the bench.

City League

Players, Coaches & Managers:

- Must be dressed neat and tidy for all games – no sweats or pajama pants.
- A sports jacket, club jacket, or neat, presentable coat is acceptable.
- Team tracksuits may be worn.
- All "club jackets" must be approved by Red Deer Minor Hockey.
