House League

HOUSE LEAGUE

Defined as a league in which the members of all teams belong to the same association. House league is open to all players of any skill level and ability and is designed to offer fun, community, and competition to the participants in a team format, while supporting a healthy and active lifestyle for all players.

COACH REQUIREMENTS

- NCCP Coach Initiation in Sport Module
 - Making Head Way eLearning Module
 - Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders or Safe Sport - Direct Athlete Contact
 - Volunteer Screening Requirement
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- A minimum of one member of each team's bench staff must have current, valid minimum standard certification from a recognized First Aid program or active employment in a recognized health care profession in which first aid techniques are commonly applied.
 - Teams must have one member with this Standard First Aid at all training and playing events. All proof of Standard First Aid or Equivalencies must be submitted to your Club Coaching Director.
 - At least one member of the bench staff must be a non-playing female, age eighteen or older and present on the bench for all sanctioned events.



- All bench staff requirements must be completed by **October 31st** of the current playing year to be an eligible member of the Bench Staff.
