11. FINANCIAL UPDATE

- Greg Krawetz explained that the Audited Financial Statements are not ready for the AGM. SaskSport is in support of the SLA having our AGM and then approving the Financials later at a Special Meeting of the Members.
- Greg Krawetz and Jordan St.Onge explained the current situation with SaskSport and the Sask Lotteries Trust fund. The SLA has been removed from the eligibility list for a period of one year. The SLA can re-apply for eligibility in April of 2027. The SLA is still an Active Member within SaskSport.
- Jordan St.Onge will email all Member Associations a letter communicating the SaskSport funding situation.

12. RESOLUTIONS (POLICY, BYLAW, ARTICLE OR CONSTITUTION CHANGES)

- Greg Krawetz discussed the Bylaws, which need to be updated. The Sport Law Group is reviewing our Bylaws to ensure they are in compliance with Lacrosse Canada Bylaws and the Canadian Sport Governance Code. Many of our current Bylaws do not pass the current standards. The Sport Law Group are finishing their review to make sure everything is legal and compliant. As soon as this is done, we can move forward with new Policies.
- Joe Laprairie discussed a policy change proposed back in December. This will not be reviewed at this time. The SLA AGM next year will be back on track, to be held in the normal January to March timeframe.
- Ryan Poelzer asked about the travel policy. This has not been approved at the AGM and is not in place yet.

13. NEW BUSINESS

a. **Lacrosse Day in Saskatchewan** - Travis Williams discussed Lacrosse Day in Saskatchewan. Saskatchewan Rush players were in attendance. It was great to be on the floor with those players. Travis thanked volunteers that helped with that event.

b. **Lacrosse Canada Fee Increase** -Jordan St.Onge discussed the Lacrosse Canada fee increase to \$30 dollars per member. This will be in effect for the 2026 and 2027 season.

c. **2026 Lacrosse Canada National Championships** – Jordan St.Onge stated that we are sending four Teams (U13 & U15 Male and Female) to Minor Box Nationals in Halifax, we are send one Team (U17 Male) to the Alumni Cup (Field Nationals) in Langley, one Team to the President's Cup in Edmonton and we are hosting the Jenny Kyle Cup (U19 Women's Field) in



Saskatoon. There were no Junior Rush Teams because the Junior NLL program did not run this year. We had also planned to send a U17 Men's Box Team to Halifax, but the team folded due to several players dropping out at the last minute.

d. **Coaching Certification Updates** - Chris discussed the Coaching certification requirements. The Coaching Pathway has been posted on the SLA Website. All Coaches need the required certification within 2 years of Coaching to attend Nationals.
