

## Softball Association of Sylvan Lake

### Full Objects of the Society

1. To promote, develop, and govern youth softball within the community of Sylvan Lake and surrounding areas.
2. To provide organized softball programs that support skill development, teamwork, sportsmanship, and personal growth for athletes of all ages and abilities.
3. To operate recreational and competitive softball teams, leagues, camps, clinics, practices, and development programs.
4. To foster a safe, inclusive, respectful, and positive environment for players, coaches, officials, volunteers, and families.
5. To establish and enforce rules, standards, and policies that align with Softball Alberta, Alberta Amateur Softball Association, and relevant provincial sport guidelines.
6. To recruit, train, educate, and support coaches, managers, officials, and volunteers through certifications, mentorship, and development opportunities.
7. To organize and host softball games, tournaments, special events, and community activities that promote the sport locally.
8. To collaborate with the Town of Sylvan Lake, local schools, community partners, and provincial associations to advance the development of softball programs.
9. To manage the financial, administrative, and operational affairs of the Association in a transparent, responsible, and sustainable manner.
10. To acquire, maintain, lease, or manage equipment, uniforms, facilities, and resources necessary to support softball operations.
11. To raise funds through sponsorships, fundraising activities, grants, donations, or other lawful means to support the Association's objectives.
12. To encourage volunteerism, community engagement, and leadership among youth, families, and members involved in softball.
13. To provide equitable opportunities for participation regardless of gender, ability, background, or financial circumstances.
14. To promote physical literacy, healthy living, mental wellness, and lifelong participation in sport within the community.
15. To develop, implement, and enforce policies addressing fairness, safety, respect, discipline, and conflict resolution within the Association.

16. To support athlete pathways from grassroots to higher levels of play, including competitive, regional, provincial, and future academic or athletic opportunities.

17. To establish partnerships with local businesses, organizations, sponsors, and community groups to enhance programming, accessibility, and affordability for families.
