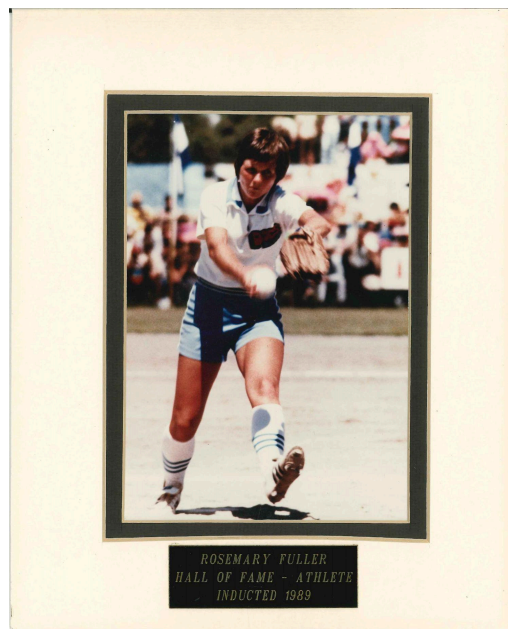


Rosemary Fuller

1989 Inductee - Athlete Category

Rosemary started playing softball at the age of fourteen and would later decide to become a pitcher, a role she would quickly excel in. Playing for the Victoria Vicettes, the team decided to take advantage of the 1973 Canada Summer Games trials. Throughout the trials, Rosemary and her catcher, Joanne Mick, would be the battery for all four games, guaranteeing their right to represent BC at the Canada Summer Games.

Soon Rosemary began playing for the Doc's Blues (then known as the Vancouver Green and Louie). In 1976, competing with the Doc's Blues, Rosemary led her team to victory, winning the Canadian championship. Rosemary's softball career with the Doc's Blues took her all over the world playing in countries such as Japan, Philippines, New Zealand, Australia, Tahiti, Hong Kong, and El Salvador.



Rosemary collected numerous Top Pitcher and MVP awards across local, provincial and international levels. Her impressive pitching led her to winning many tournaments throughout her career. Rosemary's accomplishments have been recognized through her induction into the BC Sports Hall of Fame, the Greater Victoria Sports Hall of Fame and the Softball BC Hall of Fame, cementing her legacy as one of British Columbia's greatest softball players.

Career Highlights

- 1970 – Top Pitching Award Recipient at the Senior B Provincials
- 1972 – Vancouver Festival of Sports Tournament MVP; recorded 33 strikeouts and batted .545
- 1972 – Senior B Provincial Champions
- 1973 – Canada Summer Games Silver Medalist
- 1974 – Senior A Canadian Champions
- 1975 – Drafted by Orange County Lionettes Professional Team (but declined)
- 1975 – Canadian Championships Silver Medalist winning Player of the Day, All-Star Pitcher and set a new record for most K's in a Canadian Championship (49 K's in 39 innings)
- 1975 – Named as Victoria's 'Athlete of the Year'
- 1976 – BC Provincial Champions and Top Pitcher Award Recipient
- 1976-77, 1979-80 and 1982 – 5x Canadian Championships Gold Medalist
