



FUNDING: Canadian Senior Nationals

(New as of August 24, 2026)

1. Squash Alberta will consider funding for an Adult Squash Alberta member playing in the Open or age group Main Event at the Canadian National Senior Squash Championships (CNSSC) who meets ALL OF the following eligibility criteria in the current season:
 - a) Is a Squash Alberta Member in good standing;
 - b) Is a primary resident in Alberta (Primary resident means the player has been primarily residing in Alberta and playing in Alberta for at least 180 days prior to the Alberta Senior Provincial Closed Championships)
 - c) Fully participates in the sanctioned Squash Alberta Events, in the current season, as follows:
 - i. Alberta Senior Closed Provincial Championships
 - ii. Must fully participate in the CNSSC.
 2. Squash Alberta will grant funding to the top two (2) ranked eligible Squash Alberta adult members within their assigned age group or Open event at the Canadian National Senior Squash Championships, as per section 1 above.
 - a) When a player plays “down” in a lesser age group see note 1 below.
 3. Ranking will be determined by Squash Alberta Rankings effective the start date of the Canadian National Senior Championships.
 4. Funding will equal \$150-\$200 per player, depending on the total number of eligible players being considered for funding.
- Fully participates is defined as follows:
 - The Player must complete all assigned matches during the event. Withdrawing (WD), Retiring (RE) and Defaulting (DF) during an event will not meet the definition of Full Participation and therefore will not count towards the eligibility criteria.

Exemptions: No exemptions or appeals will be considered in determining the eligibility for senior funding as outlined in this policy.

Note 1. If a player competes in another age group, funding will be based on their assigned age group. (i.e., A 51-year-old plays in the 45+ division: funding will be based on their ranking amongst the age assigned 50+ division players)
