



Masters Provincial Team Selection

(New as of August 24, 2026)

Canadian National Master's Team Championships

Squash Alberta will partially fund a seven-person team at a set dollar amount per person (based on event location) to attend the Canadian Master's Team Championships. Squash Alberta will pay the entry fee for the team, supply a team uniform, and provide partial funding for travel expenses.

If the event is hosted in Alberta, Squash Alberta has the option to enter two (2) teams. If it is decided by the Squash Alberta Board of Directors to field two (2) teams, Squash Alberta will pay both teams' entry fees, supply team uniforms, and provide partial funding for travel expenses for nonlocal players.

In the event two (2) teams are fielded there will be an A Team and a B Team. The A team will be comprised of the highest ranked players that meet the age criteria.

Team selection will be made effective the Monday following the last Squash Alberta sanctioned Singles Tournament of November in the current season and will be based on Squash Alberta Rankings and the Age Criteria at that time.

The team will consist of seven players in the following categories:

Women's 40+ 45+ 50+

Men's 40+ 45+ 50+ 55+

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Must be an Adult Member of Squash Alberta in good standing.
2. Must primarily reside in Alberta in the current season. (Primarily reside means that a player has been primarily residing in Alberta and playing in Alberta for at least 180 days prior to the Canadian Masters Championships in the current season.)
3. Must fully participate* in a minimum of one (1) Squash Alberta Sanctioned Singles Tournament between Dec 1 of the prior season and the end of November in the current season.

4. Must meet the age criteria as of the beginning day of the event (Canadian National Master's Team Championships).
5. All players must have a current Club Locker Rating to play in this event.
 - a. Current rating is defined as a rating containing a minimum of three (3) matches entered in the Club Locker system within 180 days of the Canadian National Master's Team Championships in the current season.

*Fully participates is defined as follows:

- b. The Player must complete all assigned matches during the event. Withdrawing (WD), Retiring (RE) and Defaulting (DF) during an event will not meet the definition of Full Participation and therefore will not count towards the eligibility criteria.

Exemptions for Master's Team Selection:

Exemptions and/or appeals will not be considered for Master's Team Selection.

** If Squash Alberta is unable to field a full team with eligible players, Squash Alberta reserves the right to apply exemptions to be able to field a team(s) for the event.
