The Diamonds

All games are played at Topham Park. There are 3 diamonds numbered from 1 to 3 with Diamond 1 (John Shelton Diamond) being the largest and Diamond 3 being the smallest.

The washrooms and snack bar are located near Diamond 1. All proceeds from the snack bar go to the league to help keep costs down. On weekends, the BBQ crew cooks up Hamburgers, Sausages and Hot Dogs, so please support the league by purchasing something great to eat or drink.

League Events

There are several events that occur during the season (please check the website for the posted dates):

Glove and Cleat swap: In 2007 we started a used equipment swap. This is an opportunity to donate used equipment that you no longer need or pick up equipment that you do need.

Player/Team Photo Week: Your coach will provide you with the date and time (either before or after your scheduled game) for team and player photos. Players that are unable to attend the scheduled time for their team can check the schedule on the website to arrange to have their photo taken during another team's photo session.

Bunfeed: On Bunfeed Day, coaches and players are treated to a hot dog, chips, and a drink. Coaches will let their teams know the week prior to their "bunfeed" if it will be before or after their scheduled game.

Playoff Weekend: Playoffs are held for all divisions except U6 (Learn-To-Play) on the last weekend with final games being played on Sunday. For U6 (Learn-To-Play) each player will receive a participation trophy after their last scheduled game. Most Sportsmanlike and Most Improved trophies may also be awarded depending on the division.
