⚠️ No lacrosse balls are permitted outside the playing surface.

### **Sunday Schedules**

Team Managers/Coaches must check in before their first game to receive:

- MVP awards
- Heart & Hustle awards
- Game sheet access codes

## **TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS**

All teams must comply with current ALA Regulations. [Tournament Rules](#) are posted on the tournament website and must be reviewed by all teams prior to competition.

### **Rosters**

- Maximum roster: 18 runners + 2 goalies
- Affiliates must be marked "AP" on the game sheet and must comply with ALA Regulation 5A
- Overage players are not permitted unless approved by the ALA Executive

### **Bench Staff**

- All coaches must meet Lacrosse Canada/ALA certification requirements
- All trainers on the bench must have a minimum certification as per ALA regulation 13.05

### **Out-of-Province Teams**

Must carry:

- Approved travel permit
- Travel permit roster (if applicable)

## Equipment

- All goalie equipment must comply with Lacrosse Canada / World Box Lacrosse sizing standards.
- Any equipment exemptions must be approved through the applicable provincial and LC process, and approved exemption documentation must be available at games/tournaments if requested.

## CODE OF CONDUCT

The Titans Classic has proudly operated for over 20 years with an emphasis on sportsmanship, respect, fair play, and a positive lacrosse experience for all participants. The tournament maintains a strict **ZERO TOLERANCE** policy regarding abuse or misconduct directed toward tournament committee members, volunteers, officials, players, coaches, fans, or facility staff.

All teams, coaches, players, and spectators are expected to conduct themselves in accordance with all ALA Regulations, including Regulation 12 – Discipline and Code of Conduct Policies.

The following behaviour will not be tolerated:

- Discriminatory or abusive language
- Threats, taunting, intimidation, or physical aggression
- Harassment of officials, coaches, volunteers, players, or spectators
- Intoxication-related misconduct involving alcohol or drugs
- Inappropriate spectator behaviour, including excessive noisemakers or disruptive conduct

**ALA Regulation 12.A.09 – Abuse by Fans** will be strictly enforced throughout the tournament. Any fan abuse, as determined by tournament officials, referees, or ALA representatives, may result in the spectator being immediately removed from the facility. Games will not resume until the individual has left the arena area. Failure to comply within a reasonable time may result in game forfeiture by the associated team.

Tournament officials reserve the right to remove any spectator, player, coach, or team official from the facility for behaviour deemed unacceptable under ALA Regulations. Additional consequences may include:

- Suspension from tournament participation
- Game forfeiture
- Additional discipline under ALA Regulations and the ALA Discipline & Appeals Policy

***Coaches and team staff are responsible for the conduct of their players, parents, and spectators throughout the tournament weekend.***

The tournament supplies all official game balls.

## RAMP ELECTRONIC GAMESHEETS

All games use the **RAMP GameSheets App**.

- Ensure all team volunteers doing online scoring download the RAMP GameSheets App before the tournament starts
- Managers must enter roster and bench staff at least 30 minutes before each game
- Managers for the home team must provide their scorekeeping volunteer the required gamesheet code
- *If your volunteer uses one of the “scratch sheets” they MUST have all goals and penalties entered by the end of the game so the officials can sign off*
- Ensure the games is marked complete after officials sign

## FRIDAY NIGHT COACHES CHALLENGE

Following Friday evening games, head coaches from both teams will compete in a centre-floor shootout challenge. A Tournament volunteer will meet you both on the floor after the presentation of your game awards.

### Format

- 5 shots per coach
- Most goals wins
- Sudden death if tied

Prize awarded to the winner - have fun & good luck!

## GAME PLAY FORMAT

Rules of play in Alberta shall be those of the WL Box Lacrosse Official Playing Rules with Age and Stage Modifications specified by LC except with other exceptions or changes as noted in the ALA Regulations.

Division	Allotted Time	Warm-Up /Training	Period 1	Period 2	Period 3	Period Break
U15	90 min *Stop Time	5	15	15	15	2
U17	90 min *Stop Time	5	15	15	15	2

### **Stop Time - Clock stops only for:**

- Goals
- Penalties
- Time-outs


### **Running Time Rule**

If a team leads by 6 goals or more:

- Clock runs straight time
- Stop time resumes if the lead is reduced to 4 goals

### **Final 2 Minutes**

With 5 minutes remaining of scheduled floor time, officials may reduce the game clock to 2 minutes at the next whistle to keep games on-time.

 *If games fall behind schedule, warm-ups, breaks, stop time, or game lengths may be shortened.*

## **OVERTIME & SHOOTOUTS**

### **Round Robin**

- No overtime as per ALA Regulation 9.07
- Ties result in 1 point for each team

### **Playoff/Medal Games (Sunday Games)**

If tied after regulation, overtime will commence in accordance with ALA Regulation 9.07:


1. A single sudden victory overtime period will be played (length as per division/game format)
2. If still tied, the game will proceed to a shootout

## **Shootout Rules**

- Teams alternate shooters
- Home team chooses first or second
- All eligible players must shoot before anyone shoots twice
