About Us

The MWPA has been the governing body for water polo in Manitoba since 1977. Our mission is to promote, govern, support and advance water polo in Manitoba. Together with our partners, we want to advance a safe, positive, progressive and inclusive sporting environment.

In May of 2025, the MWPA launched a Provincial Development Program (PDP) for athletes who are committed to training at a higher level as part of Team Manitoba. Our first year had its challenges, but also lots of positives. We feel that this program is important for the development of the sport in Manitoba and are committed to building it into the best possible program.

On March 22, 2026, we announced an exciting new partnership with the Winnipeg Winter Club which will become the home base for the high-performance program. At the WWC, athletes can book a lane for lap swimming anytime there are no lessons going on and dedicated training time in the pool. We also have full access to the gym and personal trainers. We can access pool time at Pan Am Pool until the scheduled closure for construction and upgrades in January of 2027.

Position Overview

The High-Performance Director will serve as a strategic leader to continue the development and implementation a High-Performance Program for the MWPA. The High-Performance Director will also play a crucial role in establishing a clear player development pathway for athletes in Manitoba.

This position requires a qualified and respected individual committed to coaching and delivering programming that will build Manitoba's capacity to compete nationally against other provincial programs.

The High-Performance Director will also assist with the organization of Provincial tournaments and camps as well as grassroots recruitment of athletes.

- Assisting with the development and ongoing refinement of the MWPA High-Performance Program
- Work alongside the Executive Director and the High-Performance Committee to set program goals
- Develop and implement training programs to help athletes achieve their goals
- Coaching high-performance and development athletes, providing constructive feedback and corrective guidance, addressing areas for improvement and reinforcing positive achievements
- Ensure training environments are positive, safe, and inclusive
- Collaborate with Competition and Technical Committee to organize and deliver tournaments and camps
- Liaise with Water Polo Canada and other PSOs
- Participate in recruitment and promotion of water polo throughout Manitoba
- Committed to applying sport science for tactical and technical advancement
- Work alongside established and developing clubs to offer support for high-performance and development training
- Communicate effectively with other coaches, players, and families as needed
