Nature of the Agreement

These are part-time, contract-based positions for the provision of coaching and support services. All Age Group National Team Programs operate under the supervision of the Pathway Technical Lead.

Term

Appointments typically span one full competition cycle (e.g., Pan-American Championship and World Championship), generally over two years. Continuation into the second year is subject to a positive performance review following the first season.

Location

While WPC's head office is located in Ottawa, ON, these positions are virtual and event based.

Scope of Responsibilities

- Participation in team selection, athlete monitoring, planning and execution of training and competition periods.
 - Contribution to program reporting, including successes and areas for improvement.
 - Assistant Coaches may be asked to support some managerial tasks.

- All coaching applicants must have completed the NCCP Competitive-Development Multisport modules.
 - NCCP Certified status is considered an asset.
 - All applicants must be able to travel both domestically and internationally.
